ABLE2 Moves to Fully Remote Operations to Strengthen Support for People with Disabilities

Ottawa, ON — On Friday, August 29, 2025, ABLE2: Support for People with Disabilities announced that the organization **will transition to a fully remote operational model effective September 1, 2025**. As part of this shift, ABLE2 will no longer maintain its physical office at 312 Parkdale Avenue in Ottawa.

This strategic decision will allow ABLE2 to **reduce overhead costs** and **reinvest savings directly into its programs and services**—ensuring that more resources go where they matter most: supporting people with disabilities and their families.

“This move is about focusing on impact,” said Heather Lacey, Executive Director of ABLE2. “By shifting to remote operations, we can expand our reach, remove barriers, and make our programs even more accessible—while continuing to deliver the same quality of care and support that the community relies on.”

Key benefits of the transition include:


- **More resources for programs:** Reduced operational costs mean more funds directly support individuals and families.
- **Greater flexibility:** Services will be delivered virtually and in-person in community spaces, meeting people where they are.
- **Improved accessibility and equity:** Removing transportation, mobility, and scheduling barriers creates more inclusive support.


While the organization’s operations will be fully remote, **all programs and services will continue without interruption**. ABLE2 staff remain available during regular business hours, and in-person meetings can be arranged in accessible community venues when needed.
